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### The Smith Is Now Open

American brasserie The Smith (not to be confused with fellow newcomer [Smith's](#)) opened its doors in the East Village this week. Featuring vintage wall coverings, subway tile floors and lots of reclaimed barn wood, it's a casual, neighborhood haunt serving everything from burgers (\$10) to "almost burnt" mac 'n' cheese (\$9) to lamb schnitzel (\$17) and roasted cod (\$16). There's also a 40-ft. zinc bar pouring \$9 cocktails made with fresh herbs and juices – "Muddlers," "Fancy Cocktails" and "Long

Pours" – and more than 20 wines available by the glass, carafe and "big carafe" (that's a liter to you). The restaurant will remain open on Thanksgiving (turkey is one of the specials), while brunch service will start on Sunday, November 25th.
